NCBE scores the MBE and reports examinees' scores to the jurisdiction in which the examinee tested. NCBE does not report scores to examinees unless authorized by the jurisdiction, and then only after the jurisdiction has announced its bar examination results. MBE scores are reported on a scale ranging from 0 to 200.

The District of Columbia Bar allows any J.D. graduate of an ABA-approved law school who is admitted to another state bar to immediately waive in with a minimum score of 133 on the Multistate Bar Exam (administered in all states except Louisiana) and a minimum score of 75 on the Multistate Professional Responsibility Exam (MPRE).

What is on the Bar Exam. Most states have a two-day bar examination. Day One is the Multistate Bar Examination (MBE), a standardized 200-item test that covers six areas (Evidence, Contracts, Constitutional Law, Criminal Law, Real Property, and Torts). Day Two is usually an essay exam with state-specific (produced by local authorities) essays.
