With black powder, the power (and pressure) of loads can be simply increased by modifying the amount of powder. Pressures go up slightly and in a rather even and predictable scale in relation to the drams of black powder. Thus a two and one-half dram load was a medium-scale load of black powder in the 12 gauge.
