Verse 63. - It is the spirit that quickeneth (the τὸ, though omitted by x, is retained by all the principal editors); the flesh profiteth nothing; i. e. the "flesh" taken by itself, and apart from the life-giving Spirit which is its principium.The antithesis between "flesh" and "spirit" occurs frequently in the Gospel, and is one of the great points of Pauline doctrine.
