How Do I Format a Figure and Caption in Turabian/Chicago Style?

Chicago/Turabian citations have two elements: The footnote and the bibliography. Footnotes are represented by numbers in the text which then correspond to the number at the bottom of the page¹. They are often shorter and change² if you re-use the citation. The bibliography is the more complete citation at the end of the paper.

How Do I Format Endnotes in Turabian/Chicago Style?

Different practices apply for theses and dissertations (see Kate L. Turabian's A Manual for Writers of Research Papers, Theses, ad Dissertations [8 th ed.].; Main Body. Titles mentioned in the text, notes, or bibliography are capitalized "headline-style," meaning first words of titles and subtitles and any important words thereafter should be capitalized.

The citation style sometimes depends on the academic discipline involved. For example: APA (American Psychological Association) is used by Education, Psychology, and Sciences; MLA (Modern Language Association) style is used by the Humanities; Chicago/Turabian style is generally used by Business, History, and the Fine Arts
